

Plein Air Painting & Sketching in Southern FRANCE with ALAN FLATTMANN



St. Cirq La Popie Pathway

August 25 – September 1, 2019

Join Alan Flattmann for seven days of plein air painting and sketching in the medieval villages and countryside along the Lot and Dordogne rivers of southern France. Along the way, enjoy delicious French cuisine, delightful wines and the camaraderie of fellow artists.

The workshop headquarters will be at Domaine du Haut Baran, a beautiful old French Country Inn with fantastic scenery all around; situated in the Lot Valley among vineyards, farms, a winding river, small villages and castles. The itinerary includes excursions to many picturesque and historical sites such as St Cirq LaPopie (voted the most beautiful village in France), Rocamadour (12th century holy city constructed into the side of a sheer cliff) and the medieval city of Sarlat.

The workshop will help beginners and advanced artists conquer the challenges of plein air painting and sketching. Alan will demonstrate pastel, watercolor and drawing techniques with daily critiques and individual help in any medium. Painting sessions are usually mornings and afternoons with plenty of time for lunches and exploring. Non-painting companions are welcome and there will be much for them to do and see while the artists paint.

Alan Flattmann is a **PSA Master Pastelist**, renowned painter, teacher and author. He was inducted into the **Pastel Society of America Hall of Fame** and is a recipient of the **American Artist Art Masters Award for Pastel Teacher**, as well as numerous other awards and honors. He has taught art workshops since 1968 and has led many painting tours to Europe. This will be Alan's sixth workshop trip to Domaine du Haut Baran.



Destination

The Lot River Valley of southern France is truly a place of wonder. From the time when local inhabitants were the last to resist Julius Caesar's invasion of Gaul, the villages along the Lot and Dordogne rivers have preserved a unique quality and a leisurely way of life. Famous for its beauty, vineyards, unequaled prehistoric and medieval sites, this corner of France is an ideal location for plein air painting and sketching.



Accommodations

Domaine du Haut Baran, a charming old French Country house located just a two hour drive from the Toulouse airport and near the medieval village of Puy L'Eveque. Haut Baran boasts modern accommodations in historical surroundings, including a beautiful swimming pool and hot tub. Bedrooms have private bathrooms with American style showers and hairdryers. Breakfast is served in the dining room or the sun-drenched terrace overlooking the tranquil countryside. Dinners feature delicious French country cuisine and exquisite regional wines.

Our hosts are William and Rosalie Haas, a couple from Cincinnati, Ohio, who have family ties to the area. William spent much of his childhood in France, speaks fluent French and is an expert guide who knows where the best painting spots are. Rosalie is a gourmet cook who prepares most of the meals

Cost

The cost of the workshop and tour is \$3400* per person based on double occupancy. The fee for non-artists companions is \$3200*. Add \$700 for single occupancy. Cost includes 7 nights' accommodations at Haut Baran; Tuition for workshop; Airport transfers; Transportation for painting/tour sites and restaurants, Breakfast each morning; 3 dinners at Haut Baran (wine included); 2 lunches at Haut Baran; Arrangement for restaurants (dinners out average 30 Euros, lunches out 12 Euros); Guided tours by William Haas; all taxes and free Wi-Fi; Studio & French easel use.

**Not included in cost: airfare, meals not listed, alcohol other than wine with dinners at Haut Baran, tips, phone calls, travel insurance.*

Everyone has to fill out and sign a Haut Baran registration form. Deposits : \$ 500.00 USD per person x number of participants = _____ total deposit. Deposits can be paid by personal check or money order, payable to “William or Rosalie Haas” and mailed to : P.O. Box 337, North Bend, Ohio 45052. The \$500 deposit is necessary to secure your reservation.

Important: All Deposits are non-refundable.

Balance : The balance of your trip is due 90 days prior to departure (by May 25th) and may be paid by check or money order in dollars USD. If the final payment is not received when due, we reserve the right to cancel the reservation per our cancellation policy. Prices are in USD. Prices cover land costs only, not airfare. Price per person is based on 10 or more participants.

Cancellation/Refund : Cancellation fees are determined accordingly : 91 days prior to trip, 500.00 USD : 61-90 days prior to trip, 50% trip price: 31-60 days prior to trip, 75% trip price: 0-30 days prior to trip, no refund. Exceptions cannot be made for any reason and there is no refund for arriving late or leaving a trip early. If we must cancel a trip, all payments received to date will be refunded and this constitutes full settlement. We are not responsible for expenses incurred in preparation for any trips (even cancelled trips) , such as airline tickets, travel delays,flight cancellations or health problems. This tour will be held regardless of world events.
