About the artist



Hailing from a family of artists and scientists, Sandra Duran Wilson's work represents a beautiful blending of sounds, nature and science.

Inspired by physics, chemistry and biology as well as her strong spirituality; Sandra's work swings between realism and abstraction. Sandra's synaesthesia no doubt also inspires her work. Sounds appear as colours, numbers as music and melodies dance through her mind as she paints.

Born and raised o the border of Mexico, the Mexican people, landscape, music and culture shaped her reality as a child. Years later, she would return frequently to South America and Mexico to absorb its culture, traditions and art.

The pure fun of exploring what paint can do and her natural curiosity keep her work fresh and lively. She is continually exploring new surfaces, materials and techniques.

Her work is represented in galleries in the US and Australia and is found in corporate, civic and educational institutions and private collections globally. She experiments, paints, writes and teaches at her studio in Santa Fe, NM. She also teaches around the US, Europe and Australia. She is the author of six art technique books, several DVDs and her work has been featured in numerous books and magazines.

Creating History and Mystery is more than a painting technique, it is a way of seeing through the layers. We begin our journey exploring the hills of Lucca and our beautiful restored farmhouse. Absorb the surroundings and let their history mingle with yours. The painting classes will proceed with developing concepts for your paintings. Shapes will define the composition, your interaction with your surroundings will influence your colors and the textures will be incorporated into your paintings.

We will paint using acrylic paints and mediums. I will share with you my formulas and techniques for creating textures, building layers to create history and veiling to add mystery. We will also incorporate local materials into our mixed media piece and we will add a transfer or two. When we begin with intention, our painting will join us in the adventure. I like to think of this way of painting as intentional spontaneity. As we work, we dialogue and listen to what the painting is calling for. The layers are added and then we intuitively veil and add shapes to create mystery. You will learn new painting techniques, but more importantly you will learn innovative ways to see. Your home Casa Fiori is situated on a small hill called Capella, alongside the 16th century church of Saint Lorenzo. It offers beautiful views of the Valley and the city of Lucca. It's ideally positioned for a number of interesting excursions, including to the towns of Lucca, Volterra, Pisa, Cinque Terre

About the Region

As part of the course, you'll also have the opportunity to travel in the local area, and take in the region's most beautiful sights.

Lucca is one of Tuscany's most loved cities; a stop you simply cannot miss. The city is located on a plain at the foot of the Apuan Alps and is less than half an hour from the coast of <u>Versilia</u>. Since it isn't a hilltop village, it is ideal for anyone with mobility issues as well as for anyone wishing to take a break from climbing!

Most of the attractions in Lucca today reveal its ancient history: from the remain of the Roman amphitheatre, to the archaeological remains under the 12th century church of Saints Giovanni and Reparata, to the various towers and villas from the 12th to 16th centuries.

Extraordinarily, as the city grew and modernised, the walls that surrounded the old town were maintained which was not the case for many other cities in Tuscany, including Florence. As the walls lost their military importance, the top of the walls became a pedestrian promenade, today one of Lucca's most popular attractions. The area around the walls is well taken care of, with green grass and trees everywhere. They have in essence become a park that surrounds the city and blocks out more modern life. Here you can enjoy a bike ride around the entire perimeter, a stroll as you enjoy an ice cream, or simply as a pit stop from sightseeing!

Volterra is a town of great architectural interest located 1770 feet above the sea level, between the rivers Bra and Cecina in <u>Tuscany</u>, <u>Italy</u>. The main features are two fine castles and numerous Etruscan remains. The ambience of Volterra is extremely attractive, easily rivalling that of the more famous Tuscan destination of San Gimignano.

Cinque Terre is a small town in Liguria, and arguably one of the most beautiful places on the west coast of Italy. In 1997 Portovenere and the villages of Cinque Terre were designated by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site. It is the perfect example of the combination of nature and architecture: from its seaside promenade framing the marina to the infinite range of colours of its narrow houses, and the Bocche promontory where the church of San Pietro stands proudly.
